


Early Literacy Tip: Use pictures to build vocabulary by describing what is shown on the page






Early Literacy Tip: Repetition is great for a young child's growing mind, so go ahead and read it again!






Early Literacy Tip: Let your child turn the pages, ask them questions, and describe objects and words they point to.






Early Literacy Tip: Nonfiction, fact-based books help babies as they begin to attach words to everyday objects.






Early Literacy Tip: Keep some books with your toys, so children associate reading with fun and play.






Early Literacy Tip: Make all the animals sounds and different voices while you read. Don't be afraid to be silly.






Early Literacy Tip: Read to your child in your native language.






Early Literacy Tip: As you read together, count the objects on the page. This helps with number awareness and strengthens early math skills.






Early Literacy Tip: Read anytime anywhere! Incorperate reading into daily routines.
